- 5. Teaching and learning are at the heart of all our work; the Trust is the "Home of Thinking Hard"
- 6. All schools within the Trust have strong numbers and an excellent reputation in the local community
- 7. There are significant areas of expertise within the Trust in which to "lead the field" both locally and nationally
- 8. Strategies to recruit and retain high quality staff within the Trust are highly effective
- 9. The Trust has a lead role in teacher training and staff development within the local and wider community
- 10. The Trust continues to be financially secure
